

CITY TOUR

Moscow is the capital of Russian Federation and represents a unique set of old architecture masterpieces and modern high-tech buildings. If you want to know more about the history of the Russian capital, you need to take this City tour! In only a few hours, you will have a glimpse of its main landmarks, such as the Red Square, The Kremlin, the Victory Park, the White House, The Arbat, Cathedral Christ-the-Saviour, the observation platform of Sparrow hills, Lomonossov University and much more! It is an interesting and efficient introduction to Europe's biggest city.

THE KREMLIN (TERRITORY AND CATHEDRALS):- Visit one of the most well-known sights of Moscow – the Kremlin with its red brick walls and 20 towers holding their own unique history. Since its first construction in 1156 as a wooden fortress by the order of Grand Duke Yuri Dolgoruky, it has been rebuilt several times. The current appearance was formed in 1495 by the best architects of Russia and Italy. Today Kremlin is the residence of Russian President and the main symbol of the country, revered by all of its citizens.

CATHEDRAL CHRIST THE SAVIOUR CATHEDRAL:- This tour is a wonderful introduction to the most majestic and grandiose cathedral of Moscow. It was edified for the first time between 1839 and 1883, in memory of the Russian's victory on the Napoleon I, in 1931 it was dynamited and reduced to rubble and then, in 2000 rebuilt again. And today among the necklace of Moscow Cathedral of Christ the Saviour is considered the main temple of the city. During the tour you will hear a lot of the little-known facts from its "biography" and admire the countless details of the stunning interior.

KOLOMENSKOE ESTATE: - The Estate Kolomenskoe is the former residence of Moscow dukes and Russian tsars. It is situated on the picturesque bank of the Moskva River. There, in calm natural environment, you can enjoy the stunning views of Moscow suburb. This museum-reserve comprises the Church of the Ascension, the restored wooden luxurious country residence of the Tsar's as well as several monuments of the 16th and 17th centuries whose construction had significantly influenced the Russian architecture. In 1994 Kolomenskoe entered the UNESCO World Heritage List and is now a favorite venue for the festivals and shows featuring scenes from Russian history.

TSARITSYNO MANOR: - This beautiful red and white architectural ensemble is the biggest neo-gothic building in Europe. Having a rough history it was first built as a luxury cottage for Empress Catherine the Great, destroyed, rebuilt after the original plan, abandoned during Communist times, then restored, and inscribed as a historical protected area in the late 2000's. It hasn't lost its original charm and still is one of the most beautiful and picturesque places besides the historical center of Moscow. Any time of the year is the best to take a wonderful journey through time in Tsaritsyno, as it boasts historical museums to learn about the Russian monarchs as well as calm ponds, scenic parks and a timeless atmosphere.
